The Loan Agreement is proposed to be entered into pursuant to authority contained in Section 384.24A of the Code of Iowa. The Loan Agreement will constitute an essential corporate purpose general obligation of the City and will be payable from taxes levied upon all taxable property in the City.

No public comments were received. Mayor Vander Stelt closed the Public Hearing.

**REPORTS:** A written report of water, sewer and streets was provided by Jeff Van Der Weide, Public Works Director. The Parks Committee will meet to determine which trees pose a danger and require trimming in the Village Park.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made by De Weerd and supported by Korver to approve Resolution #173 for the purpose of paying the cost, to the extent, of the construction, reconstruction and repair of street improvements. The Loan Agreement is proposed to be entered into pursuant to authority contained in Section 384.24A of the Code of Iowa. The Loan Agreement will constitute an essential corporate purpose general obligation of the City and will be payable from taxes levied upon all taxable property in the City. Roll call Vote: All Ayes. Motion carried.
