

The City Council met in regular session with the following members present: Mayor Michael Vander Stelt, Council members; Roger De Weerd, Randy Hoekstra, Bill Korver, Cindy Larsen and Sharon Vermeer.

A motion was made by De Weerd and supported by Korver, to approve the posted agenda. Vote: All Ayes.

A motion was made by De Weerd and supported by Vermeer to approve the consent agenda, which included the minutes of the February 16, 2021, regular meeting, the treasurer's report and the bills for approval. Vote: All Ayes.

Mayor Vander Stelt opened the Public Hearing for the 2021/2022 Budget. No comments were received. Mayor Vander Stelt closed the Public Hearing. A motion was and supported to adopt Resolution #177 approving the Annual Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2022. Roll Call Vote: Ayes De Weerd, Hoekstra, Korver, Larsen, Vermeer. Nays: None.

OLD BUSINESS: The council will continue to search for a person to fill a vacancy on the Planning & Zoning Committee.

The council discussed the design of Veterans' Day Banners. It was decided to put the silhouette of a soldier in the background, with the name of a soldier and the conflict in which they served on the banners.

REPORTS: Jeff Van Der Weide, Public Works Director, reported on water, sewer and streets.

NEW BUSINESS: Ryan & Nicole Hoekstra presented the City Council with a proposal to purchase lots 6 & 7 in the Boyd Addition. A motion was made and supported to accept the Hoekstra's offer of \$15,000.00 for the purchase of lots 6 & 7 in the Boyd Addition and to offer 1 year of tax abatement on this property. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: De Weerd, Hoekstra, Korver, Larsen, Vermeer. Nays: None.

Motion was made by De Weerd and supported by Vermeer to set a Public Hearing to Dispose of Public Property on March 30, 2021, at 6:30 P.M. at the Maurice Community Center. Vote: All Ayes.

A motion was made by Vermeer and supported by Larsen for a one-time by-pass of the Boyd First Addition covenants to allow 1 house to be built on 2 lots (lots 6 & 7). Vote: All Ayes.

A motion was made by De Weerd and supported by Hoekstra to approve Resolution #178 to Dispose of City owned Real Estate. Vote: All Ayes.

A decision on recommendations for semi-truck parking on city streets was tabled until the April meeting

A motion was made by Hoekstra and supported by Korver to sell surplus millings from the road re-surfacing project, for use in the city limits only, for \$10.00 per ton. Vote: All Ayes.

A motion was made by Korver and supported by Larsen to approve the Sidewalk Replacement program for 2021, with a maximum of 10 property owners reimbursed \$150.00 per yard, for up to 3 yards of concrete. Vote: All Ayes.

A motion was made by Hoekstra and supported by De Weerd to adjourn.
