**REPORTS:** A written report was given by Jeff Van Der Weide, Public Works Director.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made by Holtrop and supported by Vermeer to re-appoint Audrey Vander Stelt and Dan Bruxvoort to the Board of Adjustments. Vote: All Ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Vermeer and supported by De Weerd to approve a Revolving Loan to Kate Van Voorst in the amount of \$14,500 for re-locating her hair salon to Maurice. The terms of the loan are as follows: Proof of a 5 year lease on the proposed property location in Maurice, 20% annual forgiveness over a 5 year period, must be open 3 days per week. Roll Call Vote: All Ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Holtrop and supported by Larsen to approve a Revolving Loan to SRC Overheard Door in the amount of \$20,000 toward the construction of their new commercial building on Pine St. The terms of the loan are as follows: Funds to be issued when the building is enclosed, must be in business for 5 years under the same ownership, 20% annual forgiveness over a 5 year period, must be open 3 days per week. Roll Call Vote: All Ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Holtrop and supported by Korver to adjourn. Vote: All Ayes. Motion carried.
